**§ 119-1. Title.**

This chapter shall be known as the “Bear Creek Township Disabled Vehicle Ordinance.”

**§ 119-2. Definitions.**

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

**DISABLED MOTOR VEHICLE** — Any motor vehicle possessing one (1) or more of the following characteristics:

- A. It is inoperable and has been stored in a residentially zoned area within Bear Creek Township for more than seven (7) days.
- B. It lacks an engine, one (1) or more tires or other essential part.
- C. It is kept in such a condition as to become a haven for vermin.
- D. It is maintained in a precarious or dangerous position of location.
- E. It has broken glass or other sharp edges.
- F. It presents a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the public.

**MOTOR VEHICLE** — A vehicle which is self-propelled except one which is propelled solely by human power or by electric power obtained from overhead trolley wires, but not operated upon rails.

**RESIDENTIALLY ZONED** — Any portion or part of Bear Creek Township that is zoned for residential use pursuant to Chapter 127, Zoning.

**§ 119-3. Storage in residential districts prohibited.**

It shall be a violation of this chapter for any person to store a disabled motor vehicle, as defined by this chapter, within a residentially zoned area within Bear Creek Township.

**§ 119-4. Enforcement.**

Bear Creek Township is hereby authorized to enforce this chapter.

**§ 119-5. Violations and penalties.**

Any person(s) who violates any section of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.), plus costs of prosecution, and in default thereof shall be imprisoned for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day a violation continues shall constitute a separate violation of this chapter.
